Sport Physiotherapy Excellence Scholarship

The Sport Medicine Council of Alberta (SMCA) and the Canadian Physiotherapy Association (CPA) are now accepting nominations/applications for the **Sport Physiotherapy Excellence Scholarship**.

All those meeting the criteria below are encouraged to apply.

Award: Sport Physiotherapy Excellence Scholarship

Amount: \$1000 scholarship will be awarded annually to a post-secondary student in the field of physiotherapy with a 3.0 GPA or better who demonstrates excellence in the provision of volunteer or paid physiotherapy services in a sporting environment.

Process: Individuals may be nominated for the award, or may apply on their own. The recipient of the award will be chosen on the basis of both academic and professional merit, decided upon by the SMCA & CPA. Moneys will be paid directly from the SMCA to the individual.

Criteria:

- 1) Applicants must be enrolled in a physiotherapy program of study in a University or College in Alberta.
- 2) Applicants must have a GPA of 3.0 or better in their physiotherapy program.
- 3) Applicants must currently live/reside in the province of Alberta.

Application Procedures:

The applicant will submit:

- 1) A description of professional experiences, characteristics exhibited in the field, and future goals. This must include a paragraph on "*Why are you interested in becoming a Sport Physiotherapist?*"
(ONE PAGE MAXIMUM)
- 2) One official copy of their latest academic transcript mailed or scanned
- 3) **Two reference letters** by a former supervisor, professor, or coach.
