



Sports Nutrition Excellence Award

The Sport Medicine Council of Alberta (SMCA) is now accepting nominations/applications for the **Sports Nutrition Excellence Scholarship**.

All those meeting the criteria below are encouraged to apply.

Award: Sports Nutrition Excellence Scholarship

Amount: \$1000 scholarship will be awarded annually to a post-secondary student studying sports nutrition with a 3.0 GPA or better. Preference will be given to those individuals with volunteer/work experience in a sports nutrition environment.

Process: Individuals may be nominated for the award, or may apply on their own. The recipient of the award will be chosen on the basis of both academic and professional merit, decided upon by the SMCA. Moneys will be paid directly from the SMCA to the individual.

Criteria:

- 1) Applicants must be enrolled in a sports nutrition or related program of study in a University or College in Alberta.
- 2) Applicants can be in their last year of their undergrad or first and/or second year graduate studies.
- 4) Applicants must have a GPA of 3.0 or better
- 5) Applicants must currently live/reside in the province of Alberta.

Application Procedures:

The applicant will submit:

- 1) A description of professional experiences, characteristics exhibited in the field, and future goals **(ONE PAGE MAXIMUM)**
- 2) One official sealed copy of their latest academic transcript.
- 3) [Two reference letters](#) by a former supervisor, professor or instructor.
